Shopping Rules

- Shoppers must be female and currently enrolled high school. **Valid school ID card or other proof of current enrollment** must be presented at time of visit.
- Students will be allowed to receive one dress plus related accessories and makeup, as available. Items are limited in quantity.
- Shoppers are asked to limit their time in the boutique to 1 hour.
- Formal wear often runs small, so you may have to go up a size or two from your “street size” to find a dress that fits.
- **CELL PHONES AND CAMERAS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE BOUTIQUE!** Phones are allowed in waiting areas **only**. Violation of this policy will result in confiscation of phone to be returned upon check out.
- Each student will be allowed to bring **ONE FEMALE** guest with them into the boutique to help them shop. **CHILDREN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INTO THE BOUTIQUE.** Additional guests will be asked to wait in the waiting areas.
- **No males are allowed in the boutique.** Adult males will only be allowed in the waiting area. Accommodations may be available for dads or adult male guardians who would like to view their student’s dress. (Please notify the C.C.’s attendant when you check in, if needed.)
